



ON THE ROAD WITH LANCE ARMSTRONG

As a part of a worldwide marketing effort in supporting Lance Armstrong's historic final attempt to win the Tour de France for an unprecedented seventh consecutive year, a VIP bus has been specially built for the Discovery Pro-Cycling team. The luxurious bus consists of a lounge, a kitchen, a shower cabin and a bike storage room. The lounge room is furnished with massage equipment and on board entertainment.

The VIP bus is able to run air-conditioning and several communication devices such as a satellite connection and a DVD recorder (recording the races). The satellite connection allows following the detailed coordinates of the tour.

The bus has been equipped with a system consisting of a generator, a PowerMan and a Phoenix MultiPlus. The PowerMan insures a seamless transfer of power between AC sources, allowing onboard electric equipment to operate without disruption. During peak demand, the MultiPlus will 'help' the generator by adding stored battery power. When the load reduces, the MultiPlus will automatically recharge the batteries.
