On 1st of September 2012 over one thousand cyclists, runners, hikers and handbikers are going to climb the 'Mont Ventoux' mountain. This is an initiative to raise funds for the Dutch cancer society KWF Kankerbestrijding and local charity. Victron Energy sponsors this sporting trip to the summit.

The Dutch [Mont Ventoux Foundation](#) was established in 2007 and its Mission Statement is 'sports as a symbol in the fight against cancer'. The Mont Ventoux mountain climb is a sports fight that symbolically represents the fight against cancer. Each year, funds are raised for the KWF and local charity by means of the sponsoring of this mountain climb.

Mont Ventoux

The Mont Ventoux is a mountain in the Vaucluse department in the south of France. The mountain's summit is at 1912 meters. The mountain is known for its bare 'moonscape' and its level of difficulty due to the length of the climb (21.4 km), with an average ascent rate of 7.5%.

The trip

In 2007, 45 participants started climbing the Mont Ventoux, a number that has already grown to over 1,000 participants. Both trained and less trained sportsmen and women make the summit year after year. The climb starts Saturday 1 September 2012 in Bedoin, the steepest side of the Mont Ventoux.
